

Tree Preservation and Protection Plan Requirement Checklist

The following information will be included on a TPP:

- the layout and type of all TPZ barriers to be installed (refer to Table 3.1: Tree Protection Zones for Individual Specimen Trees, Ch.3 <u>Tree Protection Requirements for New</u> <u>Development</u>) including minimum distances measured from the outside of the trunk;
- recommended tree protection measures referenced in the Arborist Report, including construction details, notes and specifications (hand digging, compaction reduction measures, requirements for pruning, excavation, etc.);
- existing and proposed elevations at the base of trees to be preserved;
- proposed structures, driveways and other hard surfaces;
- areas with significant grade changes as per approved grading plans;
- areas of excavation that will require root pruning;
- construction access routes and staging areas as per construction management plans;
- servicing information as per approved servicing plans (including underground services and connections);
- erosion and sediment control measures (areas proposed for temporary stockpiling of fill or excavated material will be fenced with sediment control to prevent sediment runoff);
- Monitoring Notes and Requirements for Inspection Reports (as per the associated Arborist Report);
- Contact information (name, phone number and email) for the Arborist responsible for monitoring and inspection reports; and
- Any additional information required at the discretion of the Town.

Notes and Details:

- Light Duty Tree Preservation Fence (700) OR
- <u>Heavy Duty Tree Preservation Fence (701)</u>, as applicable; AND
- General Tree Preservation and Protection Notes (702); AND
- <u>Tree Preservation and Protection Zone Signage (703)</u>.
